Dear Parents,

Following the changes to the administration, assessment and submission and resubmission criteria, we have had to fully review our BTEC courses. The changes mainly impact on the Level 2 and Level 3 courses.

We have therefore looked very closely at the courses on offer at CAL and have decided to transfer over to ASDAN and OCR. This is mainly an administrative change. As you know, the government has mandated that students continue with Maths and English until they reach an equivalent GCSE - A to C standard.

We have therefore planned several new courses through ASDAN and OCR, one of which is the new iMedia course at Level 2 which will be offered for the first time this academic year. Next year, we will offer the ASDAN CoPE qualification.

The Certificate of Personal Effectiveness (CoPE) is a wideranging qualification, the purpose of which is to enable candidates to develop and demonstrate personal, key and employability skills, to broaden their experience and manage their learning in a variety of real life contexts. This quantifies and formalises their preparedness to progress into further education, for study at level 3, for vocational training and apprenticeships, and for employment and life.


We are hoping to produce some more polished drama pieces throughout the year and really give our students a chance to demonstrate their creativity and talent.
